WHAT EVENTS ARE HAPPENING?

Aspen's Old Fashioned 4th of July Celebration will be on Monday, July 4 with the parade from 11 am - 12 pm and the Community Village from 10 am - 2 pm.

Other events include: Boogie's Run, Kids' Parade Bicycling Decorating, Community Village, Laser Lightshow and more. Visit aspen4th.com for list of current events and times.

WHAT IS THE THEME FOR 2022?

DO I NEED TO REGISTER TO BE PART OF THE PARADE?

- Yes.

Parade registration is required by May 27, 2022. Applications can be filled out online at aspen4th.com or dropped off at City Hall (427 Rio Grande). Space is limited for groups, so the earlier you submit your application, the better! All parade applications are subject to the approval of the 4th of July Parade and Festival Board of Directors. You will be notified once your festival application has been approved.

IS THE PARADE FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE?

- No.

Parade registration is required by May 27, 2022. Applications can be filled out online at aspen4th.com or dropped off at City Hall (427 Rio Grande). Parade floats will be approved by the Commercial Core and Lodging Commission (CCLC). Registrants will be notified of their acceptance into the 4th of July Parade by June 15, 2022. All parade participants will be assigned a designated position in the parade.

NEW! COMMUNITY VILLAGE

- This year we will be hosting a Community Village, along various downtown streets and Wagner Park from 10 am - 2 pm. This celebration is free to the public and features a parked car show, live music and dance, plus community organizations.

We encourage local artists, small businesses, non-profits, and communication organizations to participate in the Community Village with a booth space and activities for all. This is your chance to be front and center with the Aspen locals and visitors! Space is extremely limited for groups, so the earlier you submit your application, the better!

Organizations interested in reserving a space at the festival can submit their Village booth registration at aspen4th.com or download a pdf and submit to City Hall (427 Rio Grande). A standard space is 10' x 10'. Booth registration does not include tables, chairs, canopies or electrical connections. Vendors who intend to sell merchandise or services are required to obtain the appropriate permits from the City of Aspen.

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
